



Summer 2019 – 8th Grade to Algebra I Bridge Program



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Intended Purpose: Success for all Sumner County students is always our focus. The Summer Math Bridge Program is intended to provide the upcoming freshmen class an opportunity to better prepare for High School Algebra I during the summer months prior to the start of their 9th grade year. The course focuses on pre-requisite skills for the Sumner County Schools Algebra I Scope of Work.

Target Audience: Fall 2019 – Incoming Freshmen

Equity: All students who have completed 8th grade during the 2018-2019 school year will be enrolled in this course but are not required to complete it. The course can be completed by students on any web browser at any location where there is WI-FI. (Due to reliance on video instruction, Google Chrome is the preferred browser.) This is an optional preparatory course to improve student opportunity for success in high school Algebra I.

Instructions for Completion:

1. Students should log in to their Clever account using their Google login information.
2. Select the Edgenuity icon under “Sumner County Schools Applications”.
3. The student should be automatically logged in and upon initial log in, a short introductory video will play to teach students system navigation.
4. Upon video completion, students will arrive at their “Student Dashboard”.
5. Students should then select “**SCS - Math 8-Freshman BR**”.
6. At this point, students may now complete the course.
