

## Peer Tutoring Application 2021-2022

**\*\*Deadline: August 10th\*\***

Peer tutoring will be offered as both a semester or year long course. There will be projects and assignments based on what classroom you are placed in and how long you are a peer tutor. In the peer tutoring program, you will help students with and without disabilities with their classroom work and daily life skills. You will be peer models and are expected to follow the GREEN Wave Guidelines.

If you are chosen to be a year long peer tutor, you will spend one semester in the CDC room and one semester in either a Special Education Classroom or General Education Classroom.

These two options should be taken into consideration when completing the questions below.

### **Types of Peer Tutoring Settings:**

**CDC Classroom:** Students in this classroom go out for related arts and a variety of other classes depending on the student. These students have the most severe disabilities including those who may use iPads for communication and are learning significantly below grade level. These students may need help in the cafeteria, during small group activities or with basic social skills.

**Special Education Rooms:** Students in this classroom only come to this room for certain subject areas. This classroom works on grade level material similar to the material that you complete in your own classes. The difference is that this class may work at a slower pace and is typically a smaller size. These students may need help with daily classroom assignments.

**General Education Rooms:** Students in this classroom are working on the same material at the same pace that you complete in your own classes. The difference is that some students may need specific help staying on task, organizing materials, completing assignments, etc.
